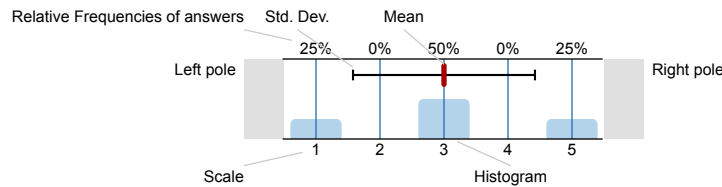

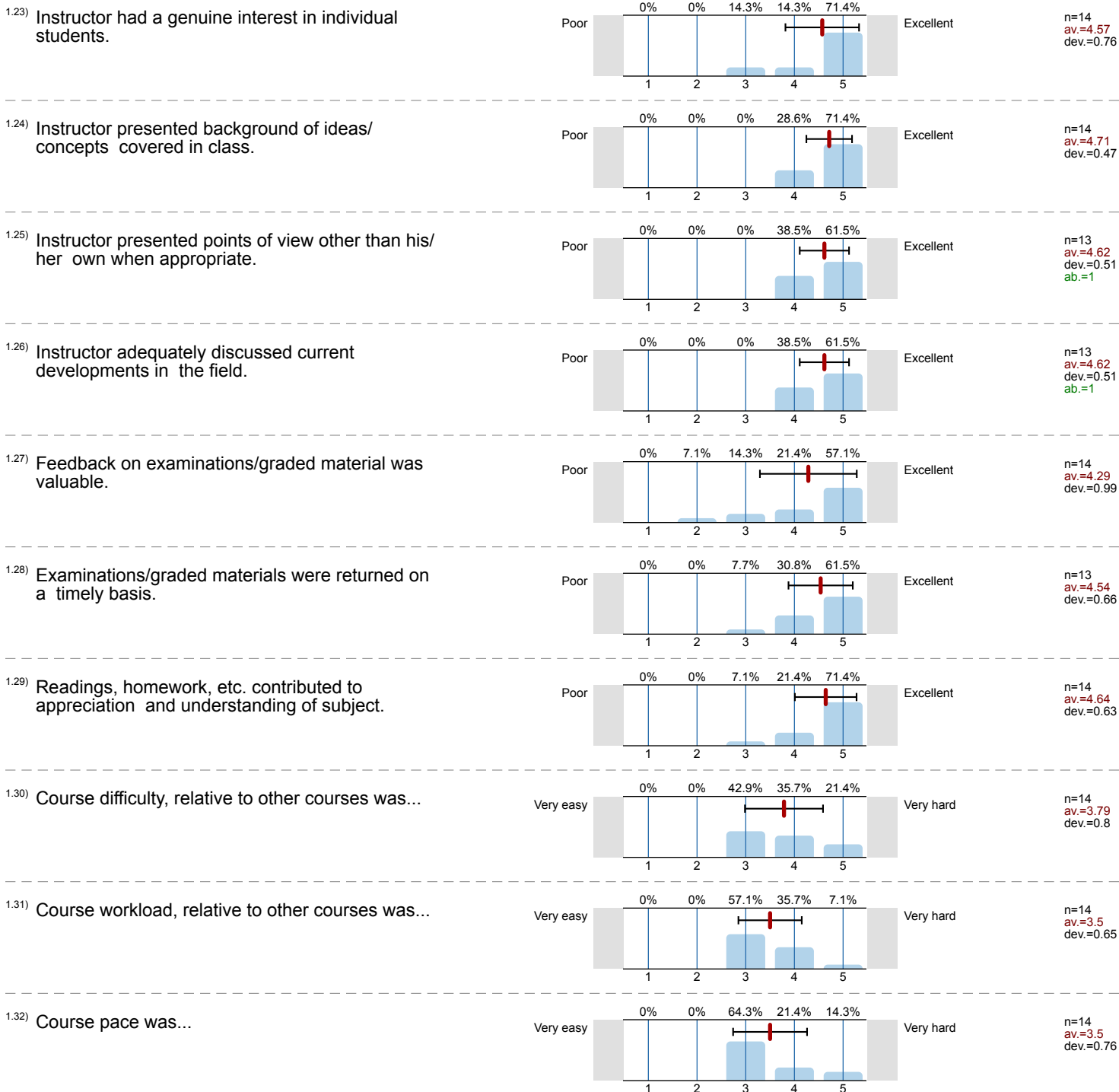

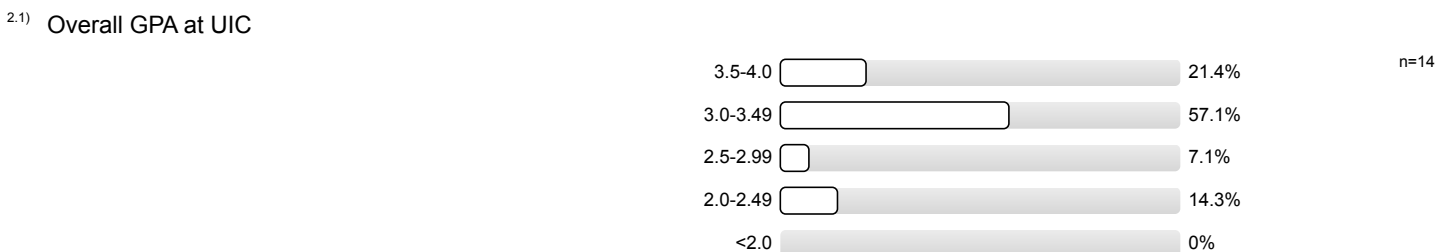

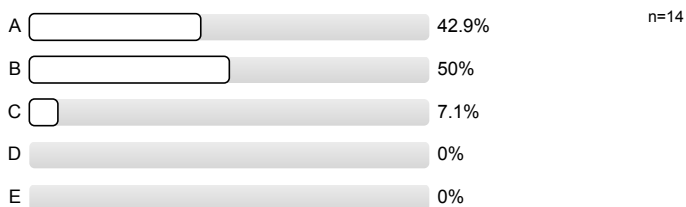

3.2) Please comment on specific aspects of the course that need improvement:

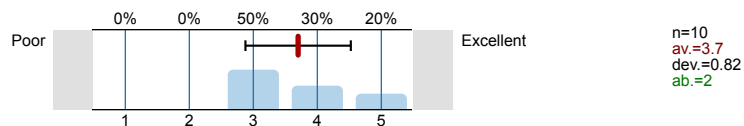

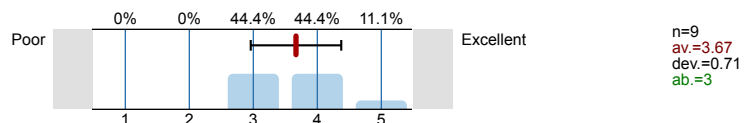

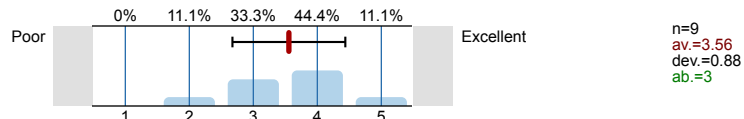
